Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware, pupils are now able to purchase fruit to eat during morning break at school. This recent scheme has proved to be very successful. The cost of the fruit is £1 per week and if you would like your child to purchase fruit next half term the cost is £5 (to cover the 5 weeks of the half term). Please send the money in an envelope with your child's name on it. The envelope should be given to your child's class teacher. If you wish to pay by cheque please make the cheque payable to Ewloe Green C.P. and please do not include the payment with lunch money. The payment for fruit should arrive at school a.s.a.p. (either before the last day of this half term or on the first day of the new term). If you wish to pay weekly please send £1 to school on the first day of each week.

Of course you may wish to provide your child with a piece of fruit from home each day.

We are strongly discouraging pupils from bringing crisps, chocolate etc for break and we ask for your cooperation in this matter. Thankyou.
