But what is Pupil Voice?

Pupil voice refers to ways in which the thoughts, wishes and opinions of learners are invited, engaged with and acted upon in an educational setting. Allowing them to take ownership of their own learning, resulting in better engagement and attainment. We task the children to create their own LOs (Learning Objectives), thinking about the skills they will be developing through completing the task.

AOLE (Area of Learning and Experience)	Focus
Literacy, Language and Communication	Building sentences using who, what, when, why ect, story writing, fact file writing, comprehension, debates - are zoos fair? Books - The Zoo Vet, Rumble in the Jungle, Norman the Slug with the silly Shell Welsh - Describing animals
Maths and Numeracy	Fractions of shape (wholes, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$), 3D shapes, column addition and subtraction, multiplication x2, x3, x4, x5, x10, classification charts, block charts.
Expressive Arts	Art - Colorful animal art in the style of Steven Brown Music - Camille Saint-Saëns - The Carnival of the Animals
Health and Wellbeing	Jigsaw,- Changes, new beginnings. P.E - Tennis, sports day practise, orienteering, Forest school. RSE - Body parts discussion - using the correct terminology for body parts.
Science and Technology	Science - Big bird watch, life cycles, habitats, grouping animals, food chains. Design & Technology - designing pet carriers DCF - JIT5, book creator, AI Magic Image
Humanities	History/Geography - Animals around the world, the seven continents. Religious Education - The ten commandments

Help from Home

Reading - Reading is an integral part of learning so to help us to support your child, we ask that parents sign reading diaries regularly, if possible three times each week.
