## But what is Pupil Voice?

Pupil voice refers to ways in which the thoughts, wishes and opinions of learners are invited, engaged with and acted upon in an educational setting. Allowing them to take ownership of their own learning, resulting in better engagement and attainment. We task the children to share what they would like to learn about, whilst thinking about the skills they will be developing through completing the task.

AOLE (Area of Learning and Experience)	Focus
Literacy, Language and Communication	Report Writing and developing story writing techniques.
Maths and Numeracy	2D and 3D shapes - nets and their properties, Statistics, Decimals and percentages, Converting units and Volume
Expressive Arts	Drama - bringing stories to life Art - Creating pupil led artwork inspired by space Music - creating space soundtracks to support dance
Health and Wellbeing	Jigsaw - positive relationships, understanding growth and change, self/body image and puberty PE - Sports day practice, Rounders and Tennis
Science and Technology	Exploring Earth and space. Designing and creating planets.
Humanities	History/Geography - Exploring changes in the earth and space. Pupil led explorations. RVE - How did the world begin?

## Help from Home

**Reading** - Reading is an integral part of learning so to help us to support your child, we ask that parents sign reading diaries each week. Children in year five are expected to read both independently and to an adult where possible. If you are able to listen to your child read, please ask them a range of questions about the text - that would be great! Please send in your child's signed reading log, on a Monday.

**MathShed and Spelling Shed** - Activities will be set each week and grown ups are encouraged to support children on these activities. These relate to learning in school too so will give children an opportunity to consolidate their learning. We ask for children to complete eight games of their spellings and eight games of their MathShed each week. Homework will be checked on a Monday morning.
