Allowing them to take ownership of their own learning, resulting in better engagement and attainment. We task the children to share what they would like to learn about, whilst thinking about the skills they will be developing through completing the task.

Children in year five are expected to read both independently and to an adult where possible. If you are able to listen to your child read, please ask them a range of questions about the text - that would be great! Please send in your child's signed reading log, on a Monday.

MathShed and Spelling Shed - Activities will be set each week and grown ups are encouraged to support children on these activities. These relate to learning in school too so will give children an opportunity to consolidate their learning. We ask for children to complete eight games of their spellings and eight games of their MathShed each week. Homework will be checked on a Monday morning.
