But what is Pupil Voice?

Pupil voice refers to the way in which the thoughts, wishes and opinions of learners are invited, engaged with and acted upon in an educational setting. Allowing them to take ownership of their own learning, resulting in better engagement and attainment. We task the children to create their own LOs (Learning Objectives), thinking about the skills they will be developing through completing the task.

AOLE (Area of Learning and Experience)	Focus
Literacy, Language and Communication	Letter writing. Information writing. French- Colours. Welsh-Expressing opinions.
Maths and Numeracy	Multiplication & Division, Mass & Capacity, Time, Money, Statistics
Expressive Arts	Art- landscapes- Flintshire and Wales Jonny Duddle-local illustrator. Music- Violin.
Health and Wellbeing	PE -Rounders, Athletics (Sports Day) Circle Time - Jigsaw lessons.
Science and Technology	Science- Healthy Lifestyle Design & Technology-Sphero- coding, and designing Ewloe Green.
Humanities	History- Changes in the local area. Geography- Map work, Human and physical features of the local area. Religious Education - Local places of worship.

Reading - Reading is an integral part of learning so to help us to support your child, we ask that parents sign reading diaries regularly, if possible three times each week.
