Our topic for this term is **'In the Garden'**

Overview of the of 6 AOLEs for this term

AOLE (Area of Learning and Experience)	Focus
Literacy, Language and Communication	To explore stories about the garden, To begin to write sentences using finger spaces and full stops. To talk about stories and retell them in different ways. To make predictions about how stories may end. To talk about our favourite stories and why we like them. To look at rhyming words and begin to spell familiar words independently when we write. Write descriptions of minibeasts.
Maths and Numeracy	To use ordinal numbers when telling stories. To tell the time using o'clock. To use addition and subtraction correctly. To use directional language. To measure height and weight. To explore 2D and 3D shapes in our environment. To record data and discuss what we find. To look at symmetry. To find half of a shape and half of a number.
Expressive Arts	To use a variety of skills and materials to create pieces of art. To listen to a variety of music that tell stories and use dance to perform them. To look at the work of Matisse and make a Matisse style snail. To create a symmetrical picture of a butterfly.
Health and Wellbeing	To practise races and take part in Sports Day . To understand what makes us special and why we must be kind to our friends. Discuss how we can make friends and keep friends.
Science and Technology	To understand that materials have different purposes. e.g recycling To look at living things and how they grow. To understand how a seed grows and what it needs to grow. Discuss the needs of a plant and our needs and look at similarities. To plant our seeds and care for our garden. To explore different minibeasts in our garden and to understand 'The Life Cycle of a Butterfly'.
Humanities	To understand why we need to take care of our environment . To gain a wider understanding of Wales and our locality. Discuss a famous artist (matisse). Discuss families and name family members and discuss how families are different.

Please continue to help your child with reading at home.

Please ask children to sound out 3 letter words and ask them a range of questions about the text.

Books will be changed in school every Monday and Thursday. They will also be assessed on their allocated words which are located in their reading records too.
