Welcome

Starting nursery is an exciting step, though it may take time for children to adjust. The nursery provides a **safe, caring environment** where children grow **physically, socially, emotionally, and intellectually**.

Curriculum

Children follow the **Curriculum for Wales (since September 2022)**, which includes 6 areas of learning:

- Expressive Arts
- Health and Wellbeing
- Humanities
- Language, Literacy & Communication
- Maths & Numeracy
- Science & Technology  Literacy and numeracy are developed across all areas.



Learning Through Play

- Children learn through **indoor and outdoor play**
- Access to a wide range of resources
- Activities include:
 - Independent play
 - Small group “busy jobs” led by staff
- Topics change each half-term and are shared with parents



Daily Routine

Each session includes:

1. Reading time & registration
2. Busy Board (date, weather, etc.)
3. Choosing and playing
4. Adult-led activities
5. Story, songs, and rhymes to finish
6. We have P.E once a week

Session times:

- Morning: 8:30am – 11:10am
- Afternoon: 12:30pm – 3:10pm



Clothing

- Uniform is **optional**, but practical clothes are recommended
 - Suggested items:
 - Yellow polo shirt
 - School sweatshirt
 - Black/green joggers
 - Waterproof coat
 - Label all items clearly
 - Bring a coat every day (outdoor play in all weather)

Absence:

- Inform the school via phone, email, or text
 - Keep children home if unwell

- Children bring a **healthy snack from home**
 - Examples: fruit, yogurt, vegetables
 - Drinks (milk or water) are provided

Supporting Learning at Home

You can help by:

- Talking and listening to your child
- Sharing books and stories
- Practising nursery rhymes
- Involving them in everyday activities (cooking, shopping, gardening)
- Encouraging mark-making and early writing
